Civic engagement, political participation, and grassroots action are essential to positive change.

Whether it's through calling your elected representative, writing a letter to the editor, composing op-ed pieces, registering to vote, showing up in numbers to the polls, speaking out against injustice, or demonstrating peacefully and lawfully, you can make a difference.

Tips for Effectively Communicating with Legislators

Know What You Are Asking Legislators to Do

Whether you are making a one-on-one visit to a legislator; writing a personal letter; making a phone call; or sending an email—know specifically what you are asking legislators to do. Do you want them to:

1. Sponsor or oppose a bill
2. Co-sponsor a bill
3. Vote for or against a bill
4. Write to leadership on behalf of or opposition to a bill
5. Talk with leadership on behalf of or opposition to a bill
6. Talk to colleagues on behalf of or opposition to a bill
7. Testify in favor or opposition to a bill
8. Speak on the chamber floor in favor of or opposition to a bill
9. Propose amendments to the bill.
10. Call you if they have any questions or need additional information or clarification.

One-on-One Visits

Preparing for Your Meeting—

Your meeting success is built on preparation.

- Identify legislators with which you want to meet. (See Appendices page)
- Read the action alerts and the bill!
- Know both the bill name and the bill number.
- Know what if any amendments need to be made to the bill.
- Decide who in your group will speak on each of the points related to your issue.
- Develop talking points using data to support your request for support or opposition of the legislation.
- Gather materials that can be left with the legislator that summarizes and clarifies the talking points.
- Identify other organizations, groups and legislators in support of or opposition to the legislation or the recommended amendments.
- Know the status of the legislation.
- Anticipate questions or challenges.
- Prepare responses.
- Expect the unexpected.

Participating in the Meeting—

- Offer a sincere greeting to the legislator and offer appreciation for taking time to speak with you.
- Leave a call slip if the legislator is not available to see you (See Appendix 3.)
- State the purpose of your meeting.
- Present the merits of the legislation you are asking support for or opposition to
- Ask for the legislator's position on the issue and why.
- Do show openness to counterarguments and be prepared to address them.
- Avoid argumentation. Remember this is to be a dialogue and not a debate (See Appendix 4.)
- Summarize the meeting at the end and reaffirm the commitment made by the legislator.
- Thank the legislator as you leave for making time to greet and hear you.

Following Up on Your Meeting—

Never forget that your visit was two-fold. First to seek support for a position you hold. Second and maybe most important, is to develop a positive working relationship that can be built upon. Therefore, follow-up is extremely important.

- Send any information that was requested during your meeting.
- Send a personalized thank you note that reflects your conversation. (See sample in Appendix 5.)
- Track future action by the legislator on the issues you discussed. Be sure and send follow-up letters, emails, or make a phone call thanking the legislator for actions taken on behalf of the issues. At the same, strongly communicate your disappointment in actions that oppose your position. This needs to be done in a factual and non-threatening manner. (See sample in Appendix 6.)

Personal Letters

When possible, follow-up with personal letters. Legislators track the number of letters they receive on various bills before them. A few letters at the right time can make a difference on how a legislator votes. Form letters do not count as much as personal letters. The sample letter below is meant to be used as a template. Please adapt it for your own use. It is provided merely as an example of the key elements that need to be included.

Phone Calls

Phone calls should be used sparingly. When a bill is scheduled to be heard in committee, amendments are being drafted or a bill is being called to vote, phone calls may be necessary. They are also effective if made on a political action day you are unable to attend.

- Use phone calls strategically. Remember every time you place a call, you are taking time away from a staff member who is working on something else. So, do not develop a reputation for being a nuisance. Instead make the most of the calls you do make.
- Make a script to prepare what you are going to say. Then say it in two to three sentences. A script will make you more comfortable, focused and prevent you from rambling.
- Call your personal legislator and give your name and mention you are a constituent of that legislator.
- Talk to an aide if you are unable to speak to the legislator.
- Develop a telephone tree and share calling responsibilities with a number of other individuals on the same day.

EMAILs

Emails are generally less effective than personal letters. When unsolicited, Emails may be seen as interference. Imagine opening your EMAIL to follow-up on important notes you viewed earlier in the day and find your inbox filled with 300 new EMAILs. Frustration may blind the legislator to your issue.

Importance of Legislative Staff

Legislators depend heavily on their staffs to track constituent interest on bills, conduct research and develop briefs and position papers that distill information for their review. They are also frequently more accessible than legislators and have the attention and ability to contact legislators at almost any hour. They work long, hard hours and certainly deserve your respect. Without their ears, you are less likely to get your message heard.

How to Introduce New Legislation? (To be developed later)

What Is the Difference between an Act, Bill, Policy, Regulation and Rule?

Frequently the terms act, bill, policy, regulation and rule are used interchangeably. However, they have different meanings and reflect various stages of the legislative and implementation process. Many of the following definitions along with other terms are to be found in the Legislative glossary at <http://www.ilga.gov/legislation/glossary.asp>.

Act— An enforceable law of the State. A bill that has passed both houses of the General Assembly becomes an Act through the Governor’s approval, inaction, or a veto procedure.

Bill— Legislation drafted in the form of an Act for introduction into the Senate or the House of Representatives and identified with a bill number. If the bill is passed by both houses and signed by the Governor or otherwise becomes law, it becomes an Act.

Policy— A permanent, widespread, well-settled practice that constitutes a standard operating procedure of the city, county or state.

Regulation— A rule issued by an administrative agency or a local governmental body prescribing conditions or authorizations that must be followed by the public or by public utilities; the process of controlling by restrictions or rules.

Rule-- A code of procedure adopted by each house of the General Assembly to govern its operations; a code of procedure developed by the responsible agency to govern an act.

A Comparison Between Dialogue and Debate

Dialogue is collaborative: two or more sides work together toward common understanding.	Debate is oppositional: two sides oppose each other and attempt to prove each other wrong
In dialogue, finding common ground is the goal.	In debate, winning is the goal.
In dialogue, one listens to the other side(s) in order to understand, find meaning, and find agreement	In dialogue, one listens to the other side(s) in order to understand, find meaning, and find agreement
Dialogue enlarges and possibly changes a participant's point of view.	Debate affirms a participant's own point view.
Dialogue reveals assumptions for reevaluation	Debate defends assumptions as truth.
Dialogue causes introspection of one's own position.	Debate causes critique of the other position.
Dialogue opens the possibility of reaching a better solution than any of the original solutions.	Debate defends one's own positions as the best solution and excludes other solutions.
Dialogue creates an open-minded attitude: an openness to change.	Debate creates a close-minded attitude, a determination to be right.
In dialogue, one submits one's best thinking., knowing that other people's reflections will help improve it rather than destroy it.	In debate, one submits one's best thinking and defends it against challenge to show that it is right.
Dialogue calls for temporarily suspending one's beliefs.*	Debate calls for investing wholeheartedly in one's beliefs.
In dialogue, one searches for basic agreements.	In debate, one searches for glaring differences.
In dialogue, one searches for strengths in the other positions.	In debate, one searches for flaws and weaknesses in the others position.
Dialogue involves a real concern for the other person and seeks not to alienate or offend.	Debate involves a countering of the other position without focusing on feelings or relationship and often belittles or deprecates the other person.
Dialogue assumes that many people have pieces of the answer and that together they can put them into a workable solution.	Debate assumes that there is a right answer and someone has it.
Dialogue remains open-minded.	Debate implies a conclusion.
